Mustard Sensei began his Yoshinkan Aikido training well over 40 years ago with Kimeda Sensei. After achieving the 3rd Dan, he left Toronto to continue his studies at the Yoshinkan Aikido Honbu Dojo in Tokyo.

In 1987, Mustard Sensei completed the intensive nine-month Senshusei course, which is mandatory for the Tokyo riot police and the instructors of the Honbu Dojo. He was one of the first foreigners ever to receive the award for the best performance at the annual All-Japan Yoshinkan demonstration.

For almost 10 years, Mustard Sensei was trained as a student of Soke Gozo Shioda, the founder of Yoshinkan Aikido, Takeno Sensei and Chida Sensei. In 1991, Mustard Sensei was appointed Itaku Shidoin by Shioda Kancho and remained the chief instructor at Yoshinkan Honbu Dojo until he returned to Canada in 1995. Mustard Sensei achieved the rank of Hachidan (8th Dan) in 2015 and in 2011 he was awarded the title of Shihan, "Teacher of Teachers". Today, Mustard Sensei is considered one of the best Yoshinkan Aikido practitioners and teachers worldwide.
